Part 2: Responding To A Threat

When you're in the face of danger, you're either gonna flight or fight! Which one would it be? Esther faced the risk of loosing her life and still chose to fight for what's right! "Esther, Part 2" focuses on how you can stand up to threats like how Esther did!

(A) MATERIAL:

Read Esther 4: 1-17

Talk it Out

- When a threat is imposed on you or your RR, you do not need to run away. You can do something about it! That is why God placed you there! Sometimes God allows for threatening situations in our lives, so that He can be glorified through us! (Esther responded to Mordecai's request by asking the Jews to fast for her. She did not ignore or run away from the problem.)
- What do you do when you see the young people in your school who are far from God or when you are not allowed to practice your faith?

(B) MISSION:

Don't be afraid to make a stand for what (or Who) you believe in – especially when a threat is made against you. Sometimes, it is when we're tested (i.e. threatened) that our Stand matters the most!

NEXT WEEK, STEP IT UP in MAKING A STATEMENT (of your faith)! EACH DAY, do something to proclaim your faith in Jesus! (Bring & "show off" your Bible, read your Bible out loud, wear a Christian T-Shirt for extra-curricular activities, put on a cross, etc)

(C) PRAYER:

Dear God, help me to not run away when a certain threat is targeted to me. Help me to do something! Give me boldness to see my school and my friends change and come to know You. In Jesus' name, Amen.
