Part 3: If God is for us, who can be against us?

(A) MATERIAL:

Read Joshua 6:1-5, 6:27

Talk it Out

- Joshua remembered the promises of God in the beginning of the book of Joshua, 1:5-6. He knew that God was his promise keeper.
- Joshua was willing to fully obey whatever the Lord commanded him to do because he meditated on God's word day and night, Joshua 1:8.
- Joshua knew that God's presence will always be with him through the thick and thin. Why do you feel like God is not with you all the time, even during Recess Revolution when His Word says, "I will never leave you nor forsake you."?
- Joshua was famous in the land because he was a great leader or because he did all that God commanded him to do? It may seem hard to believe but people are attracted to Godliness. What is Recess Revolution known for in your school?

(B) MISSION:

TODAY, ask God what is stopping you from stepping out of your comfort zone. Write it down, **challenge** yourself to walk in the opposite spirit and **share** it with a friend during recess. "Therefore encourage one another and build each other up, just as in fact you are doing. 1 Thessalonians 5:11"
