How do we share?

Be positive, be friendly, be happy when you share the Gospel. It is the Good News after all. So don't be mad, don't shout. Just be yourself.

Don't use big Christian jargons or over spiritualised words that people might not understand. Keep it short and simple, real and relevant.

Please do give your friend the space and the time to respond to the Gospel. Don't pressure them. It has got to be their personal choice.

You don't always have to preach the Scriptures. When people ask you why you do what you do, you can simply say it's because you love them and you just want to bless them. If they ask you further why you do that, you can say it's because Jesus loves you. And then if they are open and ready, you can share with them the Gospel.

How can we prepare to share?

Keep on praying and hoping that your friends will respond to the Gospel before you share with them, when you share with them and even after you have shared with them. So don't give up. Keep hoping, keep believing, even if they don't immediately respond.

Don't be discouraged and disappointed if people reject you or make fun of you. Instead rejoice that whatever it is, a seed has been planted and it is only a matter of time that it will bear fruit.

What do we do after sharing?

If they want to know more about God or know God more personally, you can then proceed to invite them to your church or you can even lead them in prayer to accept Christ into their hearts personally. Just invite them to put their faith in Jesus and in Him alone, repent of their sins and live for God.

Remember, ultimately it is not our job to change people's hearts or minds or even to save their souls. Salvation is the work of the Holy Spirit. Sharing to them God's love and the Good News is our part. Believing and receiving Jesus Christ into their lives is a choice people have to make for themselves. If people are not ready to accept Christ yet, it is okay and it is important that you share anyway.
