Part 3: Resting in God's timing

(A) MATERIAL:

Read Ruth 3:1-16

Talk it Out

- Ruth could only rest at Boaz's feet and wait for him to respond. What are the good results that came out of her patience and trust?
- Waiting on God simply means doing the best that you can do, trusting God with the result, and not stressing about it. What are some areas in Revo that you can find hard to rest upon and trust God's timing? (eg. New projects or initiatives, sponsorships, etc)

(B) MISSION:

God wants us to rest at his feet. Too many times, we worry about what might happen if we mess up, when instead we should just do our best and leave everything to God! God will continue to encourage us, should we succeed or even when we fail!
