Jonah

Part 1: Run Away

"Wait", "Later", "Soon", these are our usual responses when we hesitate to do what we are supposed to do. Procrastinators are leaders of tomorrow, not something to be proud of. How do you develop a heart of obedience that always says "Yes" to God? In "Jonah, Part 1", we learn about Jonah's simple solution in avoiding God, which does not work at all.

(A) MATERIAL:

Read Jonah 1:1-16

Talk it Out

- Jonah received very specific instructions from the Lord but Jonah completely resisted God's command and ran away. Why do you think he ran away?
- We see that Jonah feared the Lord (v9) but why then do you think he disobeyed God? Was he not afraid of God's wrath due to his disobedience?
- What should you do when you have disobeyed God?

(B) MISSION:

What might be something that God has put on your heart that you are running away from currently? **THIS WEEK**, take the courage and step into obedience. Share it with your Revo team, so that they can come alongside you and you can all hold each other accountable.

And take the **FIRST STEP** even if you can't do it all yet. What might be the **FIRST THING** that you need to do in order to obey what God has told you?

Do not run away from God, trust Him to know the whys and how.

(C) PRAYER:

Our Father, help us to act upon the commands that you have given to us. Help us to trust in you for you are always with me, when you call you will show us how to do it. I ask that we will be obedient because delayed obedience is still disobedience. In Jesus' name I pray, Amen.
