Part 2: Guide

(A) MATERIAL:

Read Ruth 2:1-3, 2:20-23, 3:1-4, 18

Talk it Out

- Naomi encouraged Ruth to go work as well. She knew that working would help Ruth make good use of her time and be significant. Naomi also asked out of concern where Ruth was gleaning. We see that Naomi also advised Ruth to go out with other women to protect herself. Are you looking out for one another as a family of Christ?
- Naomi probably knew from experience and her wisdom on what Ruth could do. She gave Ruth very specific advice on what to do. Where does your wise counsel come from? Are you going to God's word for your counsel?
- Sometimes we also need to be patient and wait just like what Naomi advised Ruth. Are you taking time to wait upon the Lord or doing things in your own hands?

(B) MISSION:

As we get older, we learn more things. But are you feeding yourself the right things?

TODAY, challenge yourself to guide people to God's word and not your own words. Always ask God for his advice on things. Share a proverb from the bible with someone today.

(C) PRAYER:
