(A) MATERIAL:

Read Nehemiah 1:4-11

Talk it Out

- "The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit; a broken and contrite heart, O God, you will not despise." Psalm 51:17
- From Nehemiah's prayer, you can feel Nehemiah's sorrow and pain from all the corruption that his people had done. Nehemiah becomes the intercessor for his people and ask for God's forgiveness.
- As a Revolutionary, you can be the intercessor for your school and friends.

(B) MISSION:

Nehemiah also fasted as we read. **THIS WEEK**, try fasting during recess time and come together to pray for your school or a friend in school, and really spend time interceding for that particular person. Believe that God will bring a breakthrough!
