Nehemiah

Part 2: Remember the Lord

Things are going well but suddenly you hit a roadblock. You feel discouraged, annoyed and angry but as Christians we can hold onto God. In all circumstances, we are to turn to Jesus. In "Nehemiah, Part 2", we see how Nehemiah encourages his people which gives them hope.

(A) MATERIAL:

Read Nehemiah 4:1-14

Talk it Out

- Because it was after the time of exile, there were many other nationalities around who did not like the Jews. They were even more upset that they were rebuilding the wall.
- Nehemiah was someone who was fearless. We see from his response that it was because he trusted who his God was. He was not shaken and knew with all his might that God is his fortress.
- When you face opposition, who do you trust? What do you say to your fellow teammates and to yourself?

(B) MISSION:

The enemy is always trying to stop us from doing God's work. As part of Revo, you are encouraged to be like Nehemiah and continue to labour on God's work. How can you share who God is to someone in your school **today? Pray and ask** God for a name and create an opportunity to talk to that person.

(C) PRAYER:
