## Ezra

### Part 4: Confession

Confessing is when you use your mouth to profess something. Your words are powerful, so when you do confess, it is not taken lightly. God hears our confession and wants us to repent from it. In "Ezra, Part 4", we see how the people start to confess their sins before God.

#### (A) MATERIAL:

Read Ezra 10:1-16

#### Talk it Out

- We read of Ezra confessing and weeping before God and that moved people to recognize their sin. God was moving through the prayers of Ezra. Have you ever witnessed such a thing? Share your encounter.
- Ezra led the people into confession and repentance. He was ministering to them and the people responded in repentance. What is repentance?
- The people decided to turn away and stop what they were doing, they repented. Are you repenting? Are you constantly choosing to walk away from sin?

#### (B) MISSION:

Prayer works all the time in the will of God and it is because God is faithful. You want God to move? Pray.

**THIS WEEK**, minister to those in your Revo group or outside of your Revo. People are needing the touch of God to know that He exists but we need to move with God. Share with your friends the forgiveness of God over their sins.

#### (C) PRAYER:
