John the Apostle

Part 3: Immediate Response

Every time your parents ask you to do something, like, clean your room or put out the plates... do you immediately say yes and do it? As strict as it may sound, delayed obedience is still disobedience. In "John the Apostle, Part 3", we see how John responds when he is asked to follow Jesus.

(A) MATERIAL:

Matthew 4:18-22

Talk it Out

- If Steve Jobs were to come all the way to ask you to work for him, would you immediately follow him? Why did John immediately follow Jesus?
- How are you responding to God? What are some ways you can change the way you respond to God?
- Think of something that is holding you back from responding to God immediately. Share it with one another.

(B) MISSION:

The easier way to practice this is to do Pray, Listen and Obey.

Pray and **ask** God for a name and ask Him what He would like you to do for that person. Listen to His voice and **Obey** what he is telling you to do. **Share** this with your leader to keep you accountable.

(C) PRAYER:

Dear Lord and heavenly Father, I thank you for giving us the privilege to serve you and you are worthy of my obedience. Lord, help us to keep saying yes to you when you tell us to do something. In Jesus' name I pray, Amen.
