JOSEPH Part 1: Holding On

When friends say mean things and exclude you it aches your heart. It's okay to not be okay. You don't have to suppress your feeling entirely but you can cry out to God. In "Joseph, Part 1", we see how Joseph remembers every pain but remains faithful to God.

(A) MATERIAL:

Read Genesis 41: 56-57, Genesis 45:8-12

Talk it Out:

- Nothing went well for Joseph, he was sold into slavery, he was thrown into prison, but yet Joseph always did his best in everything he was assigned to do. Why did Joseph give his best when he seemed to have every right to give up?
- Joseph never once blamed God for everything that he has been through. Through it all, God used Joseph to save nations because of his perseverance and obedience.
- Have you been persecuted when doing Revo before? Share your experience.

(B) MISSION:

Just uphold to God every rejection that you face and remember that God is there for you in every condition.

Don't get carried away by the rejection you face and pray that God will change the hearts of the ones (might be your teacher or friends etc.) who are "rejecting" you in any way just because you are involved in Revo. Take a **BOLD** step to tell the one that is causing you problems that you are praying for them because God loves them too. It might change their heart!!

(C) PRAYER:

Dear Lord, first of all, thanks for establishing RR in my school. I pray that You will bless us with the courage to overcome the rejection that is distracting us from doing what You want us to do. Make us grow through this so that we can glorify Your Name! In Jesus' name I pray. Amen.
