Moses

Part 1: You Don't Have to be Perfect

"He is smarter than me." "She talks better than me." We compare ourselves to others and put ourselves down rather than encouraging ourselves. In "Moses, Part 1", we see how Moses learns to be confident in the Lord when God assures him that He will show up in the different situations.

(A) MATERIAL:

Read Exodus 4:1-14

Talk it Out

- Moses, like all of us, had a limitation. He had a problem of stuttering during his speech. In spite of this, God still wanted to use him and would help him through by putting His words into Moses' mouth.
- How are you like Moses? Are there any limitations that you are facing which sometimes stops you from sharing the love of God? (Stuttering speech, not familiar with the Bible, etc)
- Instead of putting yourself down because of your limitation, be confident that God can use you and guide you through that weakness. What are some ways that God can use your limitation to your advantage? (eg. Read the Bible along with a friend)

(B) MISSION:

Most times, all we need to do is take a step of faith and God will pull us through! *The greater the test, the greater the testimony!*

Today, **write** down 3 of the things you have not done before, which you feel is beyond your limitation. (Could it be to speak to a teacher about Christ? Pray for a close friend) **Write** them down on 3 different pieces of paper, and fold the papers. Randomly **pick one**, and **NEXT WEEK**, do what is written on the paper! God will guide you through!

(C) PRAYER:

Dear Lord, please help us to understand that You have chosen us for a calling that is greater than ourselves. Let us remember that our strength comes from You, and that nothing is impossible through Christ who strengthens us! In Jesus' name, Amen!
