Moses

Part 2: Faith Over Fear

The chair that you are sitting on, how do you know that it will not break? The things we eat and buy, we are certain that it will not kill us. In "Moses, Part 2", God wants us to give in to our doubting faith filled with fear but a faith that "sits on that chair immediately".

(A) MATERIAL:

Read Exodus 14:5-14

Talk it Out

- Waters on one side, and a horde of Egyptians on the other! The Israelites were trapped. Do you think it was right for Moses, as their leader, to feel scared?
- What are some situations that have happened to you in your school life, which you felt great fear and discouragement, but God still pulled through for you in the end? Share them!

(B) MISSION:

Moses had every right to be afraid. However, he chose not to be afraid, simply because he knew that God was on his side! Just like Moses, we have God on our sides too! Most of your non-Christian friends, do not know God or the comfort that He brings to them.

We all have friends who are going through some problems. (Could it be a family problem? Problem with his or her studies perhaps?) We can show God's love to them by lending them a shoulder or a listening ear. **Next week**, why not you go to a friend who is facing a problem in his or her life, *and be there to **listen and encourage** them? **Tell them*** that they don't have to be afraid, because God's got their back!

(C) PRAYER:

Dear Lord, keep us reminded that truly there is nothing to fear because You have been, and always will be there for us. Teach us to remain confident in Your glory so that we can be a source of hope in our schools. In Jesus' name, Amen!
