Job

Part 1: Fear God

Fierce teachers - no students would ever want to cross paths with them. How does one fear God but still constantly approaches Him? In "Job, Part 1", we see how Job is described as someone who feared God and what it means to fear God.

(A) MATERIAL:

Read Job 1:1-5

Talk it Out

- What do you think it means to fear God? Describe it in your own words.
- Job was a blameless and upright man. He would turn away from evil. He always pursued the forgiveness of God by offering sacrifices, even on behalf of his children.
- As RevoJutionaries in your school, why is it important that you show the fear of the Lord? How can you show this?

(B) MISSION:

Recess Revolution, and more importantly – YOU - are placed in your school (by God) for a purpose! (Refer to Matt 5:13-16). You are called to make a difference! To MAKE a difference, you have to first BE the difference.

THIS WEEK, **Read** Proverbs 1-5 together to learn more about the fear of the Lord. **PRACTICE** the fear of the Lord during the week. Show your friends how you have the fear of the Lord which comes from the love and reverence you have for Him.

(C) PRAYER:
