Part 3: Be a Listening Ear

(A) MATERIAL:

Read Job 2:11-13

(B) MISSION:

THIS WEEK, Pray Proverbs 1-5 and ask God who you can be a listening ear to in your school. Approach this person with God's love and compassion. Set aside time to pray with this person outside school or during recess time. Let's be active in carrying out God's word.

(C) PRAYER:
