(A) MATERIAL:

Read 1 Samuel 15:3, 9-11, 24-35

Talk it Out

- In the previous chapters we read of 2 occasions where Saul disobeys God. Here another clear commandment was given to King Saul but because he feared the people and obeyed them instead. Why do you choose to disobey God?
- Saul wanted Samuel to honour him for what he has done. Do you give God all the glory and acknowledge him?
- Saul was continuing in sin that is why God had to reject him. Are you walking in obedience? Are you hardening your heart towards God? God is a god of second chances, turn back to him, He knows your heart.

(B) MISSION:

Rejection is never nice. Have you rejected someone before or pushed them aside or ignored them?

TODAY, reach out to them that are rejected or cast aside. Go up to them and see God's grace in redeeming them. Sit next to them and start building a relationship with them.

(C) PRAYER:

Dear God and Heavenly Father, I do not ever want to be rejected by You. God, help me to walk in obedience to Your word, soften my heart Lord. Help me to reach out to those who are rejected. In Jesus' name I pray, Amen.
