## King Saul Part 4: Jealousy

Envy is a dangerous feeling which can lead to jealousy, a desire so strong that you would do anything for it. If you have it, it is good to address it before it goes out of hand. In "King Saul, Part 4", we will learn from King Saul and how his jealousy led him to a desire to kill.

### (A) MATERIAL:

Read 1 Samuel 18:6-16, 19:1-2

### Talk it Out

- David had killed Goliath in the previous chapter and he was getting famous. It says that "a harmful spirit from God rushed upon Saul". Saul had already rejected God, and God had rejected him from being king. God had a special reason for allowing this spirit to incite Saul to action against David. Saul's attempt to kill David only made Saul realize that God was with David. (The evil was not from God but God allowed it to come over Saul)
- Have you been jealous before? Share your experience and how you resolved it?
- In RR, you are to encourage one another with the things you have accomplished. It is all part of God's kingdom and it's for His glory. When was the last time you encouraged one another?

### (B) MISSION:

There are always people who are better than us but God sees all of us and loves us the same. It is not a competition. It is all done in love.

**TODAY**, encourage someone of their achievements in school or outside school. People need encouragement and words of life. Go up to the person today.

### (C) PRAYER:
